SUBJECT: MODOT Highway Safety Division Grant Applications

The grant applications to the MODOT Highway Safety Division have been submitted online at the MODOT website prior to the March 1st, 2017 deadline. These are the ongoing traffic safety grants that are renewed for each year. These grant requests are for the 2017/2018 grant year beginning October 1st, 2017 and ending September 30th, 2018.

In addition to the online submission, the attached original hard copy applications require Chief Halsey's signature. The attached authorization form requires approval by the City Manager. This paperwork will be submitted by mail and accepted by MODOT Highway Safety Division after the March 1st, 2017 deadline for online submission.

The only cost the department will incur as a result of these grants should be operation of involved police vehicles. When the grant period expires there is no further obligation to continue this project and no other costs will be incurred.
