Executive Summary:

Presentation related to the Stay Well fund and overview of post-65 coverage options.

Background:

City staff and representatives of the Stay Well Committee are working to develop a process that will provide an opportunity for representatives to identify the best option(s) for Medicare eligible retirees and dependents currently participating in the City's health plan.

The goals of this process include mutual agreement on a financially sustainable solution to the City's ongoing budget challenges while ensuring current plan members affected by this change will have an active role in selecting the best plan option(s). The goal is completing this work by this year's Open Enrollment in October.

Representatives from Lockton will present a brief status report relative to the Stay Well Fund and a general summary of post-65 coverage options. This presentation will not include details related to any specific plan or coverage options.
